ENGINE OIL TREATMENT

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

ENGINE OIL TREATMENT is a multi-purpose engine treatment designed to penetrate and restore surfaces susceptible to the formation of sludge and varnish. It is specially formulated to stabilize and enrich crankcase oil.

FEATURES & BENEFITS:

- · Works to reduce friction & wear
- · Quiets noisy lifters and valves
- · Removes and prevents sludge
- · Helps maintain target viscosity of engine oil
- · Increases engine life due to improved oil circulation

DIRECTIONS:

Check dipstick. If oil level is low, remove oil cap and add entire contents of the bottle. Engine oil treatment may be used between oil changes, however, best results are achieved when used at each oil change. DO NOT OVERFILL.

DOSAGE

Generally, one bottle of product will treat up to 4 to 5 quarts of oil. If engine is suspected to be heavily soiled with contaminants, a second bottle may be used. If a second bottle is used, it is recommended that the oil be changed after 100-200 miles of driving following treatment.
